

## **VERRUCA: ALDARA MEDIPLAST TREATMENT**

You have been prescribed **Aldara** for your wart treatment. **Aldara** is not FDA approved for common warts. It is actually prescribed for genital warts, but has been found effective for common warts.

We have found in the past that **Aldara** works best when used with **Mediplast**. **Mediplast** is an over-the-counter wart treatment. It has an acid property that takes down the thickness and dead skin of warts.

We recommend the use of **Mediplast** one (1) week prior to application of **Aldara**. Apply **Mediplast** in the morning and buff down at night with an emory board or pumice stone. This allows the wart to become soft. After a week apply **Aldara** to the wart at night. Treating this way causes the **Aldara** to effectively treat to the base of the wart. If **Aldara** was just applied, instead of **Mediplast**, it would not be able to penetrate the rough, dead skin on the wart's surface . **Aldara** should be occluded with Saran wrap and tape.
